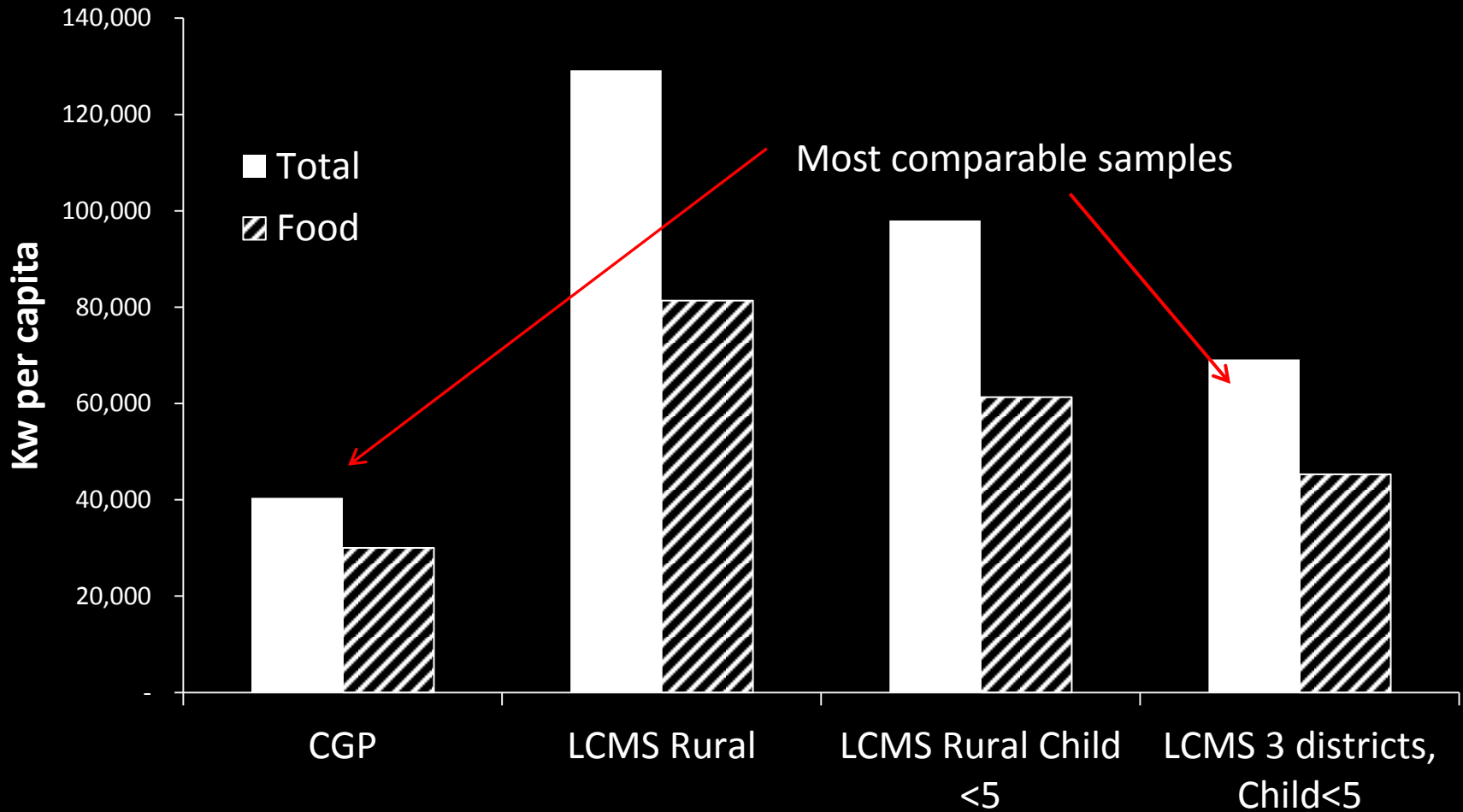
Targeting

 - Child development (health, schooling, material well-being)

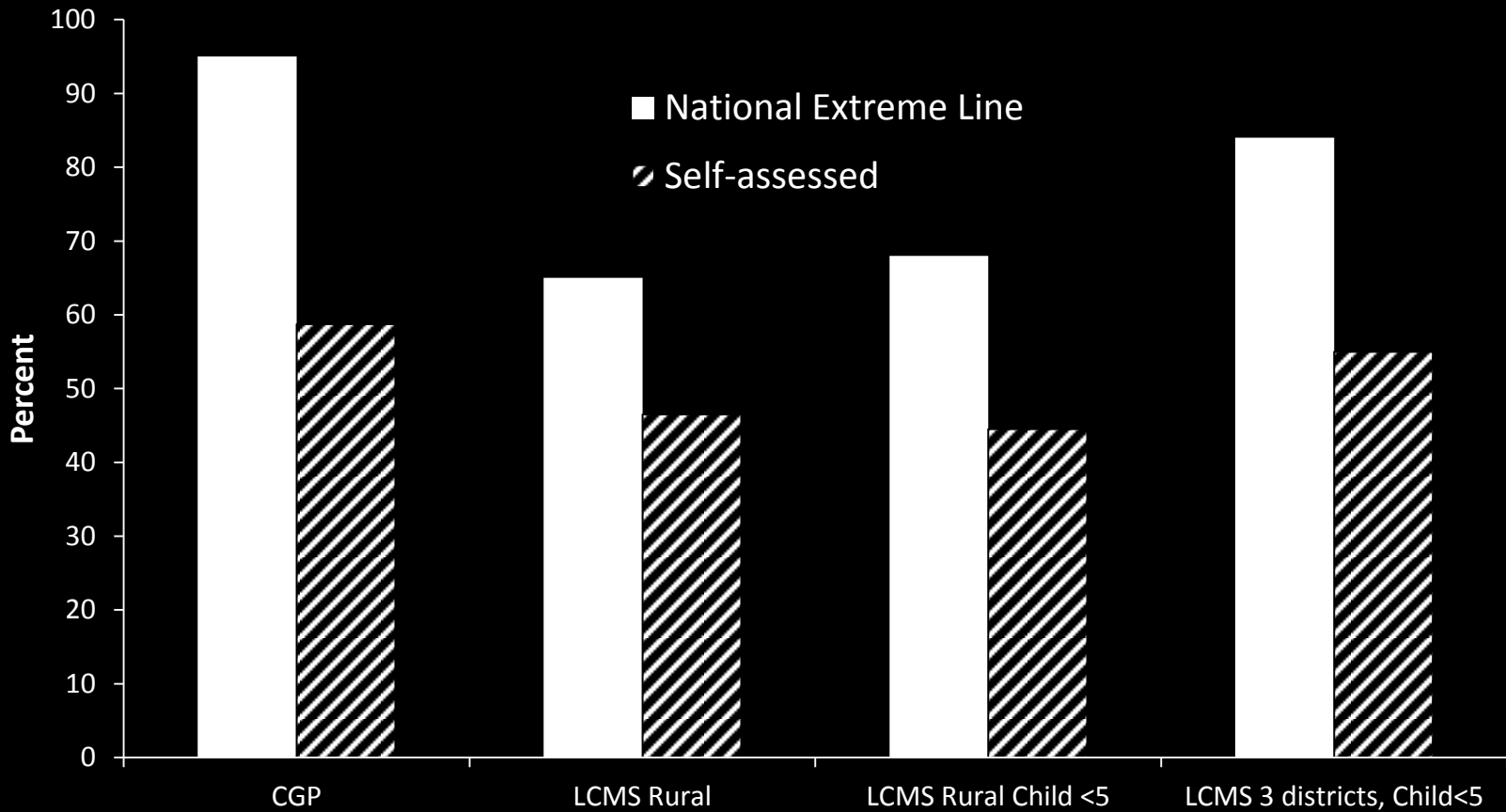
Demographic Composition: More young children!

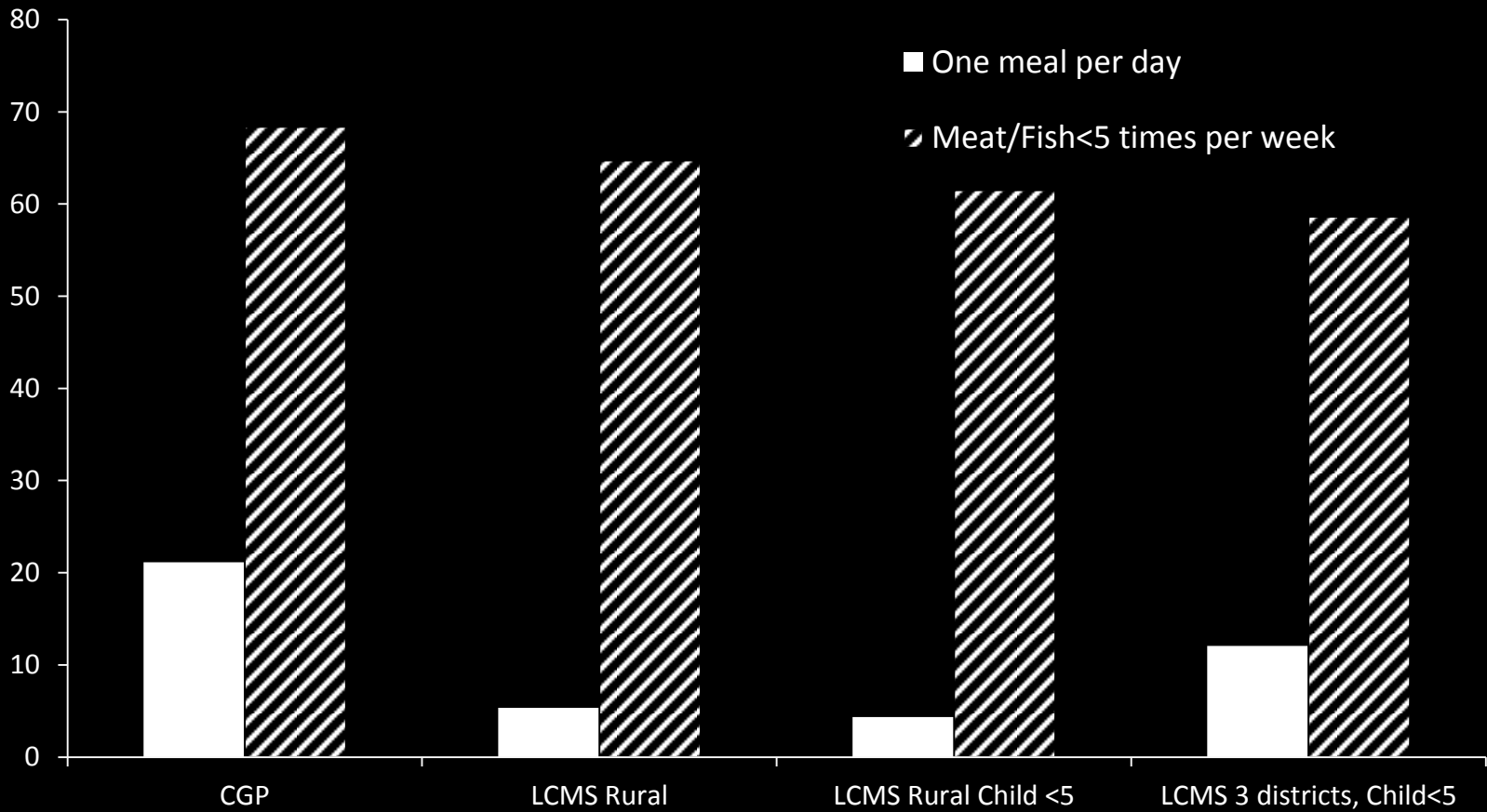
Consumption: CGP vs. LCMS



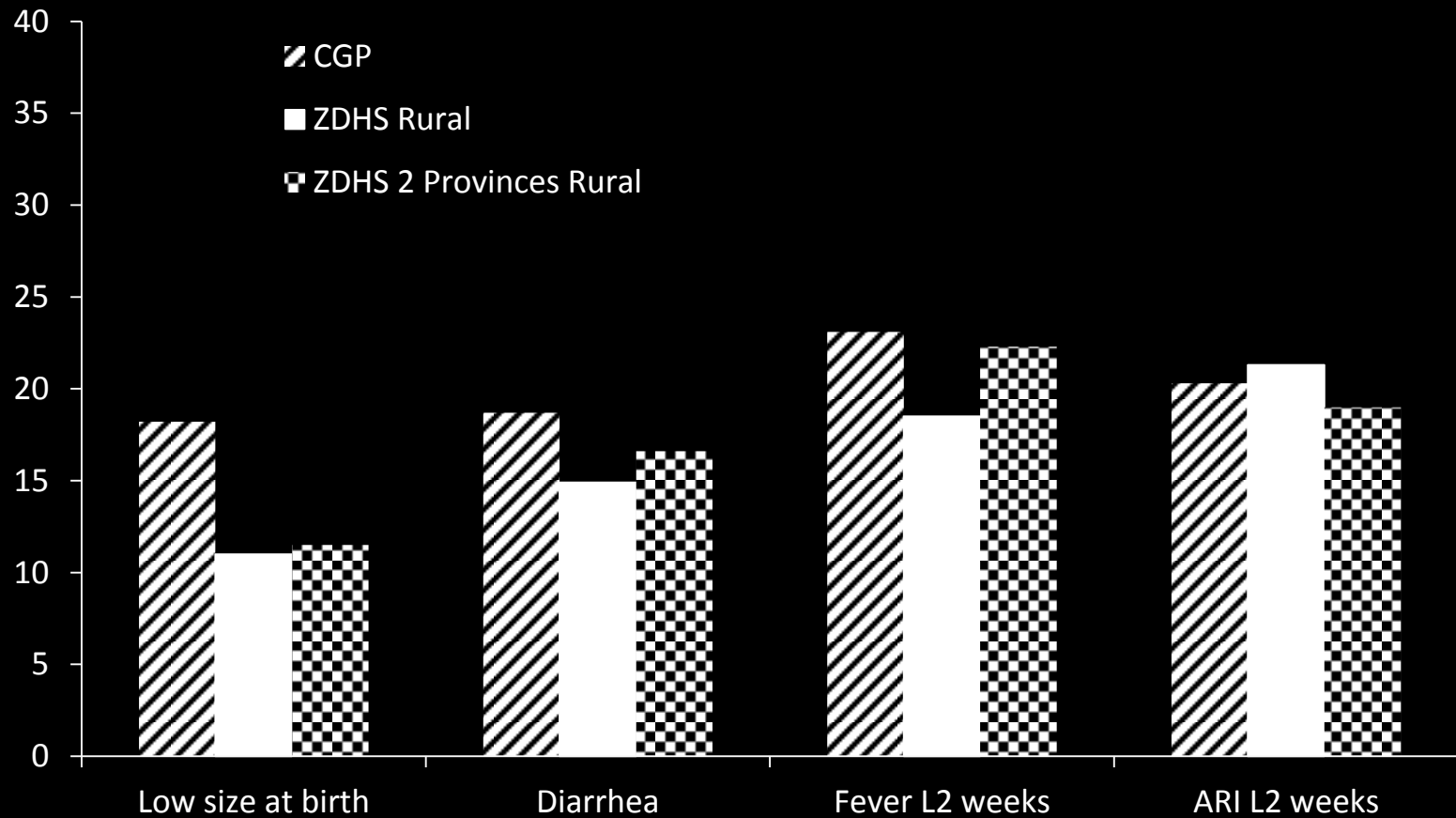
Poverty Rates: CGP vs. LCMS



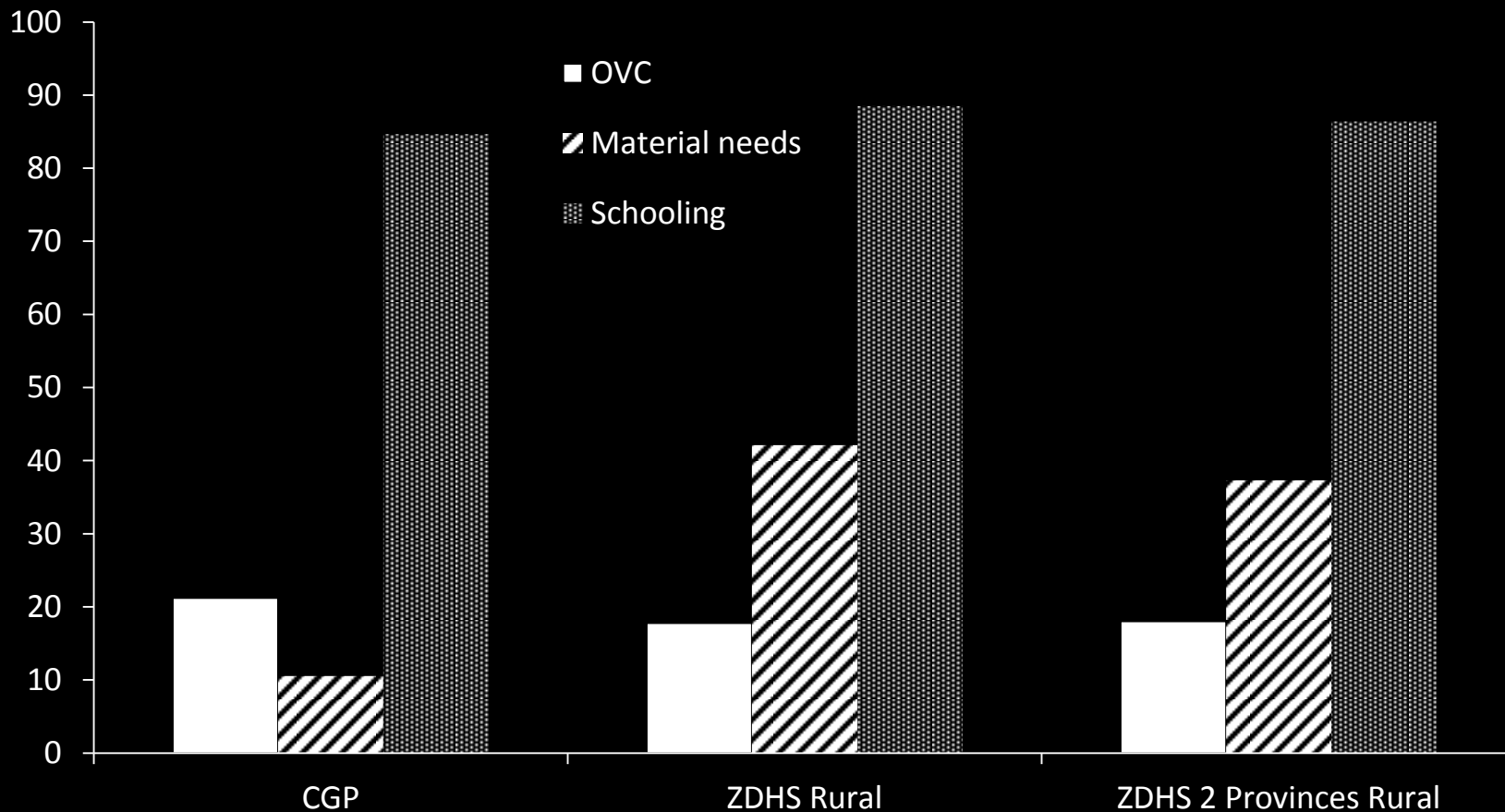
Food Security: CGP vs. LCMS
